DISNEY'S HORTICULTURE 2009 COOL SEASON BEDDING PLANT TRIALS

The Walt Disney World Trial Garden was exceptionally wet and cold this season. From October 1, 2009, through March 31, 2010, temperatures ranged from a daytime high of 94° F. in mid October to a low night temperature of 24° F. in mid January. We experienced 8 hard freezes. The coldest temperatures were from January 4, through January 13. During that period, freezing temperatures occurred on 8 of the 10 nights! On January 9th, our daytime temperature never rose over 41 F. The lowest temperature recorded was 24.1 F. during the night of January 11th. Rainfall was barely an inch in October but finished with a whopping 8 inches in March. Our total rainfall from October through March was 20.44 inches. Even with the extreme cold temperatures during the early part of our trial, many plants did so well during our spring conditions we extended their pull date.

Our Cool Season Trial Garden included 193 different cultivars. Please remember to check the “overall” column for an asterisk, which denotes cultivars that performed exceptionally well. A total of thirteen cultivars rated the best of the best.

We sincerely appreciate those companies that make our evaluation process possible. We would also like to thank those of you that make our efforts worthwhile by reviewing the data and using the knowledge to select and promote superior plants.
